

Middle School Math Teacher

Experience with honors-level Algebra I and Geometry is required, and experience with STEAM curriculum is also preferred. The candidate must be able to integrate technology in a one-to-one classroom environment. Responsibilities also include communicating student progress to parents (including parent conferences and completing student evaluations) and being available to meet with students outside of class time for additional support. In addition, this person will sponsor a math club and will assist in developing a dynamic math curriculum.
